Secretary's Report (Year 2015-16)

Mr. President and the Members of the Executive Council and Esteemed members of the Society, I have a great pleasure to place before you the report pertaining to the activities undertaken by the Executive Council with your constant guidance and help for your Society since **January 01, 2016**.

It is well known that the Indian Society of Genetics & Plant Breeding is one of the oldest and prestigious academic societies established in 1941. As we know that society is a non-profit organization of scientists and researchers focusing on promotion of science of genetics and plant breeding disciplines. The Society publishes a research journal and organizes National and International symposium/ conferences on current research trends in the field of genetics. The society functions through its biennially elected Executive Council. The cost of operations is met by the annual and life membership fee, the contributions from the subscribers of the journal, savings and donations from Philanthropic bodies.

The rating by NAAS of your journal has increased from **5.1 to 6.3**. Possibly this is one of highest increase in rating among the journals published by our fellow Societies. Now you have to see that the rating becomes one of the best through accepting stringency in reviewing, submitting your high quality papers for publication in your Journal and providing much wider, better and time bound help in referring.

Digitization of all the issues of Indian Journal of Genetics & Plant Breeding since the first publication in 1941 to 2017 was under taken in a phased manner. However, the digitization of issues of the Journal from 1941 – 2016 have been completed so far.

Society's Accounts :

Editor's Report (Year 2015 & 2016)

Mr. President, Members of the Executive Council and Esteemed Members of the Indian Society of Genetics and Plant Breeding (ISGPB), I have the great pleasure to place before you the Editor's report for the years 2015 & 2016.

Excellence and attributes of a professional Society is primarily known by its publications. The ISGPB have been publishing its Journal the Indian Journal of Genetics & Plant Breeding (Indian J. Genet.) regularly in every quarter of the year. Prime objective of the Journal is to bring out quality publications for popularization and promotion of genetics and plant breeding. During the period under report, all the issues of the Journal were published nearly on time. Each quarterly issue i.e., February, May, August and November of the journal was made available online first and the hard copies were dispatched to members within a month. During November, 2016 a special issue of the Journal was brought out on to commemorate the international year of pulses. It carried 22 articles on major and minor pulses, which were well received by the readers. In general, the waiting period for publishing a paper in our Journal has been brought down to about six months. Occasionally, undue delay happens due to factors beyond our control. All attempts were made to maintain and raise the standard of the Journal by publishing only quality papers. During 2015 and 2016 a total of **852** manuscripts including **38** symposium manuscripts from Ranchi and Parbhani chapters were received of which only **113** (4.46%) were published as full length papers and **51** (5.98%) as short communications. This includes **32** papers published from authors abroad. In total, about **549** manuscripts were rejected by the Editorial Board and the referees and rests (**139**) are under review. Online management of submission of the manuscripts is being done by the ICAR website, <http://epubs.icar.org.in/journal/index.php/IJGPB>. Efforts to notch up the quality of the publications through appropriate reviewing and editing processes has resulted in improvement the NAAS rating (6.283) of the Journal with corresponding improvement in the international impact factor to 0.283..
